

OFFICIAL RULES

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY TO ENTER OR TO WIN. A PURCHASE WILL NOT INCREASE YOUR ODDS OF WINNING. ALL FEDERAL, STATE, LOCAL AND MUNICIPAL LAWS AND REGULATIONS APPLY. VOID WHERE PROHIBITED.

ELIGIBILITY. The Trail Blazers Starting Five Contest (the "Contest") is open to Oregon and Southwest Washington residents, 13 years or older at the time of entry, except employees of Trail Blazers Inc., the National Basketball Association and its Member Teams, NBA Properties Inc., and each of their respective affiliated companies, subsidiaries, and advertising or promotional agencies, and the immediate family members of, and any persons domiciled with, such employees are not eligible for entry.

ENTRY AND RULES OF PARTICIPATION. The Contest will begin on the first day of the Trail Blazers' 2011-2012 regular season and continue through the final game of the 2011-2012 regular season, excluding playoffs (if any) (the "Contest Period"). To enter you must be or become a member of iamatrailblazersfan.com. Membership requires an email address, a computer that is Flash enabled, and full completion and submission of registration information at iamatrailblazersfan.com. Only one person per email address may enter. The Starting 5 Contest can be accessed when you log in to iamatrailblazersfan.com, click on your profile name at the top of the page, and then click on "Starting 5" in the top right part of your personal navigation. To enter, choose five (5) players to be placed in your "Starting 5" and you will receive "points" based on how those players perform per game. Points will be rewarded to the fan for the players' performance based on the following scoring breakdown:

Assist	2
Steal	3
Block	3

You may update your Starting 5 up to one (1) hour before game time and may change the players out as often as you like, as long as it is one (1) hour before game time. Once the game begins, changes cannot be made until 12:01 am the next day. The fan with the most total points during each calendar month (with the exception of first month, which shall run from the Trail Blazers' first 2011-2012 regular season game through January 31, 2012) will win a prize (each a "Winner") and the fan with the most total points at the end of the Contest Period will win a prize (the "Grand Prize Winner"). In the event of a tie, the winner will be selected from among the fans that are tied by a random drawing.

The Trail Blazers will use commercially reasonable efforts to make sure the statistics are accurate and up to date; however, all the participants understand and agree the statistics and other information provided through this Contest are provided for informational and entertainment purposes only. The Trail Blazers make no representation or warranty as to the accuracy of the point determination and reserve the right to change the point determinations as updated or changed information comes from the NBA. The Trail Blazers shall not be responsible or liable for the accuracy, usefulness or availability of any information transmitted or made available through this Contest and shall not be responsible or liable for any errors or omissions in that information.

PRIZE. There will be one Winner each monthly scoring period. Each Winner will receive an Trail Blazers Swingman jersey (retail value of \$80), and the Grand Prize Winner will receive a Playstation 3 game console (retail value of \$300).
